Proposed Amendment

Article XI

Conflict Mediation Process

- Section 1: The Reedy River Baptist Association, Inc. shall be represented by an **official** Conflict Mediation Team comprised of the moderator and the **first and second vice moderators**. Its role shall be to restore order and peace within the church congregation.
- Section 2: Each member church of the Association requesting conflict mediation shall be in **good standing** with all registration and assessment fees current with the Reedy River Baptist Association, Inc.
- Section 3: In order for the first meeting to be confirmed and scheduled, any church requesting conflict mediation shall observe the following steps:
 - A. Obtain **written consent** from the church pastor. If the pastor refuses to consent, or if the church is without a pastor, a majority vote of the deacons' ministry shall be submitted in writing for a duly called meeting between the Conflict Mediation Team and the church.
 - B. Complete the required **Conflict Mediation Request Form 003** which may be found on the Association's website: http://www.rbai.org/downloads.php.
 - C. Submit an **approved agenda** to be reviewed by the moderator and the church appointee at least forty-eight hours before the scheduled meeting.
- Section 4: The deacon ministry chairman or the church appointee shall receive a written response from the moderator or one of the vice moderators within seventy-two hours of receiving the required information.
- Section 5: The Conflict Mediation Team shall facilitate a maximum of three scheduled church meetings. A two-hour maximum time limit for each meeting shall be observed. Once the team exhausts its resolution efforts, the church shall be referred to another local, qualified, and non-legal conflict mediation agency.

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¹ The purpose of the proposed amendment is to provide a clear description of the association's role in the conflict mediation process. All member churches will have an opportunity to communicate their requests for mediation by closely observing the steps of the prescribed process.
